Mrs. Harman, Mrs. Ahlvers, Mrs. Berry and the Montclair Community Theater invite children (K-5) to participate in our stage adaptation of **Mrs. Harman's Imagination**, based on the book, What Do You Do With An Idea by Kobi Yamada

Children interested in working as **cast** members (performers) will meet on Thursday afternoons in the upstairs multi-purpose room from 3:45-5:00 pm.

Children interested in working as **crew** members (props, scenery, and costumes) will meet in the teacher's lounge on Monday afternoons from 3:45-5:00 pm. (Stage hands chosen from Crew-must attend final rehearsals with the cast)

Due to the tremendous response last year (wow! 130+ students!), this year we request children to make a commitment to become either a CAST MEMBER or a CREW MEMBER, except 5th grade students who are needed for cast and crew. All other students K-4, please return only one form indicating which choice. **A \$20 participation fee and an optional gift card donation to a craft or fabric store are due at time of registration.** Additionally, cast and crew members need to supply a large white t-shirt (men's undershirt-should be at least knee length to the child). The t-shirt is for costuming and workshop wear and will be the property of the play member after the play. Shirt should have names written in the collar with a permanent marker, please.

Our performances will be on **April 24th, 9:00 and 10:00.** (Morning Performances only)

PLEASE NOTE:

- **Cast and Crew registration dates are January 23rd and January 27th 3:45-5:00 pm in the hallway near the teacher's lounge. All forms, \$20.-fee, and t-shirts must be turned in on the dates of registration. The Montclair office does not accept registrations. Gift card donations for materials will be gladly accepted- fabric stores, craft stores, Walmart**
- All Cast and Crew members must be picked up by the Montclair office by 5:00 pm. (There will be no supervision after this time.)
- Cast and Crew members will receive a monthly calendar stating the dates he/she is needed for rehearsals or crew workshops.
- Dramatic Productions are progressive projects, additional or extended rehearsals or workshops may need to be added.
- Parent involvement, especially with crew workshops, creates a fun community project!
- Mini-classes are held during the same timeline. Avoid scheduling mini-classes on the same day as play commitments.
- Attendance is required at all rehearsals and workshops. Please notify Mrs. Harman, dmharman@mpsomaha.org, if your child should decide to not participate after registration or will be absent on a crew or cast day.
- **Dress rehearsal** will be on **Tuesday and Thursday 3:45-5:45** the week of the performance. **Dress rehearsal attendance is mandatory.**
